- For all phases, the students, in grades 6-12, will work virtually on Fridays and teachers will participate in school-wide and district-wide professional development. All school buildings will be deep cleaned on Fridays.
- Asynchronous Learning - Students learning independently using assignments posted by their teachers. Usually, learning occurs independent of the teachers.
- Synchronous Learning - Students learn in real-time with their teachers, who are guiding them through the lesson.
- Simultaneous Learning - Teachers instruct students who are face-to-face and at-home [remote] learners at the same time using the virtual platform (e.g., Zoom).
